

REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMING MANUSCRIPTS OF ARTICLES JOURNAL "THERMOPHYSICS AND THERMAL POWER ENGINEERING"

The journal publishes the results of research in the following areas: heat and mass transfer processes and devices, theory and practice of drying, communal and industrial heat energy, renewable energy, energy efficiency, fuel use and combustion, thermal power plants, ecology, thermodynamics and transfer processes, nuclear energy, monitoring and optimization of thermophysical processes.

Articles in Ukrainian or English are accepted for consideration. The electronic version of the article - in Microsoft Word 2007, 2010 is sent to the editor's e-mail: shmorgun@nas.gov.ua. If the article is written in English, then a page in Ukrainian is added to it: the title of the article, the surnames of the authors, academic degrees, ORCID profiles or Researcher ID, mailing addresses of institutions, abstract - at least 3000 characters, keywords, literature.

Structure of the article:

- page parameters: left and right margins – 15 mm, top and bottom margins – 25 mm. The font is Times New Roman, point 11, spacing 1.15. Headings of elements of the main text are highlighted in bold.
- UDC index (in the upper left corner of the page);
- the title of the article – in Ukrainian or English (pin 14, bold, capital letters);
- surnames of all authors, initials (no more than 4 persons, bold), scientific degree;
- place of work of each co-author, position, academic title, e-mail, ORCID or Researcher ID profile of the scientist;
- a short summary at the beginning of the article (3-4 sentences) in two languages - Ukrainian and English;
- keywords (4-6 words) in Ukrainian;
- the main text of the article: problem statement; analysis of recent research and publications; highlighting previously unresolved parts of the general problem; description of the research methodology; presentation of the main material and obtained scientific results; conclusions and prospects for further development in this direction; list of references;

The volume of the article, including text, tables, figures, literature, the English-language block should be up to 10-12 pages. Figures (diagrams, photos, etc.) are submitted together with the text in places of references to them with a resolution of at least 300 dpi. Captions to figures with appropriate numbering (in the order of placement in the text) must be submitted in two languages (Ukrainian and English) in italics (10 point). It is unacceptable to include captions to the figure itself.

Formula numbering – right in brackets. All physical quantities are given in the SI system. Whole parts from decimals are separated by a dot.

Tables (in portrait orientation) must have thematic headings and numbers, the table background is not highlighted in a different color. The recommended character size in tables is 9–10 pt. Table headings are submitted in two languages (Ukrainian and English).

The list of references is given in the original language in the order of mention in the text with the DOI identifier of the source. The list of references (between 15 and 30) is numbered in the order of mention in the text. Font – Times New Roman 11 pt, authors' surnames – in italics. Abbreviations of the names of cited sources are not allowed.

The English block should include:

- title of the article in English (capital letters, bold);
- surname, first name, patronymic of all authors - in transliteration, in bold;
- full names and mailing addresses of the organizations where the authors work (in italics);
- academic degree, (title), scientist profile (ORCID or Researcher ID) for each of the co-authors;
- abstract in English (extended, approximately 2500 – 3000 characters), structured, containing the goal, objectives, research methods, results;
- bibliography in the form of: References 20, tables 2, figures 5;
- keywords;
- a list of literary sources in Latin, as in the article, but the names of the authors are in English (transliterated from Cyrillic); the name of the non-English article is in the English translation in square brackets; the name of magazines, other literary references - in square brackets in English. At the end of each reference (of a non-English edition), the original language of the article must be indicated in parentheses: (in Rus.) or (in Ukr.). Articles published in foreign journals are submitted in their original title.
- list of literary sources in Latin, as in the article, but the authors' surnames – in English, then – its English translation in square brackets; the name of the journals (transliterated from Cyrillic and translated into English – in square brackets. At the end of each reference (for non-English editions) in brackets, the language of the original article must be indicated: (in ukr.), or (in rus.) Articles published in foreign journals are submitted in the original title, with digital DOI identifiers.

The article must be accompanied by:

- an official letter addressed to the director of the institute, signed by the head of the organization in which the work was performed;
- a printed manuscript of the article, signed by all authors;

- an e-mail address and contact phone number of one of the co-authors for correspondence with him.

Documents should be sent to the editorial office's mailing address: 03057, Kyiv, Marii Kapnist St., 2, ITTF NAS of Ukraine, editorial office of the journal "Thermal Physics and Thermal Power Engineering".

If the article, after passing the double "blind" review and the absence of comments from reviewers will be accepted for publication (about which the editorial office will send a corresponding notification to the e-mail address), the author must sign the Copyright Transfer Agreement (posted on the journal website www.ihe.nas.gov.ua). The agreement is sent to the postal (original) or e-mail address (scanned copy) of the journal editorial office. Publication of the article is free of charge. All materials are distributed under the terms of the Creative Commons Attribution License International CC-BY.

Manuscripts of articles that do not meet the editorial requirements will not be considered.
